



## Important Additional OBAP Solo Flight Academy Instructions:

Our goal at the OBAP Solo Flight Academy is to excite young people about flying and their potential in the aviation field. We bring this excitement to life through academics and actual aircraft flying culminated by an aircraft solo flight. The academy activities form the foundation of a productive career in aviation or other professional fields. Your son/daughter will receive approximately 10 hours of flight time and 40 hours of ground school. Therefore the following are required:

- 1. All students must be between the ages of 16 and 19, on the first day of the Academy.**
2. Students attending a Solo Flight Academy must also obtain a FAA 3rd Class Medical/Student Pilot Certificate from an FAA Medical Examiner. (Cost approximately \$75.00 - \$100.00). If a copy of the certificate is available now, please enclose. If not, you will be notified of date required. It must be received before an acceptance letter is sent to applicant.
- 3. TSA requires proof of U.S. citizenship prior to start of flight training. A copy of proof MUST be received before start of your session. Your director will provide more specific local instructions.**

**a. TSA Citizenship Requirements**

Any U.S. citizen applying for training to be used towards a recreational, sport pilot, private pilot (single or multi-engine) certificate, multi-engine rating at any level, or instrument rating, in an aircraft weighing less than 12,500 pounds must present the flight school or flight instructor with evidence of U.S. citizenship. Evidence may be shown by **one** of the following.

1. A valid unexpired U.S. passport
2. An original birth certificate of the United States, American Samoa, or Swains Island, and government-issued picture ID
3. An original U.S. naturalization or citizenship certificate (Form –550 or –570) with raised seal and government-issued picture ID
4. An original certificate of U.S. citizenship with raised seal (Form –560 or N561), or a Certificate of Repatriation (Form –581), and government-issued picture ID
5. An original certificate of birth abroad with raised seal (Form FS-545 or DS-1350) and government-issued picture ID.
