TSA Citizenship Requirements

Any U.S. citizen applying for training to be used towards a **recreational, sport pilot, private pilot (single or multiengine) certificate, multiengine rating at any level, or instrument rating**, in an aircraft weighing less than 12,500 pounds must present the flight school or flight instructor with evidence of **U.S. citizenship**. Evidence may be shown by **one** of the following.

1. A valid unexpired U.S. passport
2. An original birth certificate of the United States, American Samoa, or Swains Island, and government-issued picture ID
3. An original U.S. naturalization or citizenship certificate (Form -550 or -570) with raised seal and government-issued picture ID
4. An original certificate of U.S. citizenship with raised seal (Form -560 or N561), or a Certificate of Repatriation (Form -581), and government-issued picture ID
5. An original certificate of birth abroad with raised seal (Form FS-545 or DS-1350) and government-issued picture ID
