### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- \* Must be a current member of OBAP in good standing and complete OBAP scholarship application.
- \* 1500 hours Total Time-Fixed Wing.
- \* 100 hours flown in the past year (Recent of experience).
- \* Current FCC license.
- \* Current First Class Medical.
- \* High school diploma or GED equivalent.
- \* Must be authorized to study in the United States
- \* A college degree from an accredited school is preferred.
- \* Must have a valid US Passport
- \* 100 hours Turbine Time

Please note that PIC is defined as Captain/Aircraft Commander of record, not simply the sole manipulator of the controls. Pilot time for minimum qualification only considers time in fixed wing aircraft.

All Scholarship recipients will be responsible for their own transportation, lodging and meal expenses.

*Only qualified applicants will be interviewed at the convention. Training will be conducted at the United Airlines Flight Training Center in Denver, Colorado.*

All interested applicants must submit a current resume and 2 letters of recommendations of which one must be from a current OBAP member.
